

Expression of Interest 2022 Arterie Training Program Arts + Health Hospital Practices - Design + Delivery

Arterie is an international award-winning art program designed to deliver the creative arts to marginalized communities, and operates in collaboration with established providers of healthcare. The program provides bespoke models of art engagement for all hospital stakeholders - patients, families, carers, staff, volunteers + visitors. The multi-pronged model supports a holistic approach to innovative health support by normalizing the hospital experience and easing the side effects of illness such as stress, pain, fatigue, isolation and depression.

Arterie is delivered to Royal Prince Alfred Hospital and Chris O'Brien Lifehouse. It delivers 3 core programs to reach diverse locations and groups within the hospital; Carterie Program on the Wards + Treatment spaces reaches Inpatients; Workshop Program in Atrium space reaches Outpatients; Artist in Residence Program in Hospital Foyer Entrances reaches patients, visitors + staff.

The training covers the design and delivery of all 3 programs. These observatory and participatory programs provide a distraction from treatment and a less clinical atmosphere with positive outcomes. Past research demonstrated that

- 91% stated that it helped cope with stress (anxiety, worry, sadness)
- 89% stated that it took patient's mind off treatments
- 89% stated that it helped patient cope with treatment

Please note in addition to completing the application form attached to the EOI, you will be invited to an interview with Arterie as spaces are limited, and once accepted for training, you are required to complete a hospital formal application process as a 'Volunteer.' Hospital applications can take up to two months to be processed and approved, so please note key dates listed below. There is no charge for the training and all materials/resources are supplied. You will be provided with an orange apron, and are expected to wear team uniform of white pants/shirt.

SCHEDULE

The training is delivered 9.30 - 3.30 pm every Wednesday and you are expected to attend weekly for the duration of the year to complete the training. You will receive a combination of theoretical information and clinical practice. During the first half of the year (March – July) there will be weekly lectures, and during the second half of the year (Aug – Dec) monthly professional development practices to consolidate the training. Holiday leave requires approval around key training dates.
